Attaching to Wall Studs

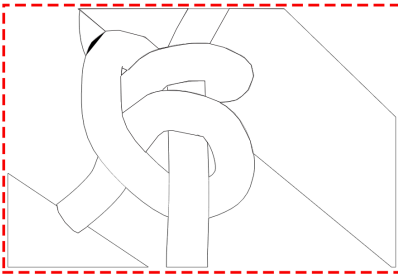
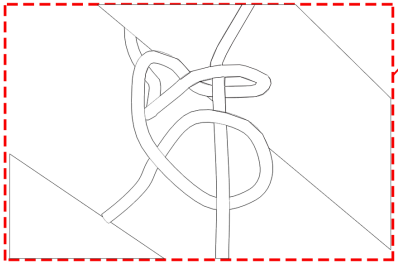
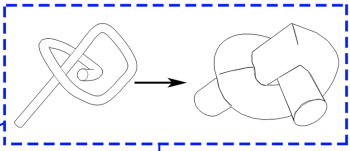


Use a studfinder and mark the wall where the center of the studs are. Studs are typically 16" apart. Measure the distance between your studs to confirm. Mark, level, and predrill holes in the wall to attach parts 17 with screws H.

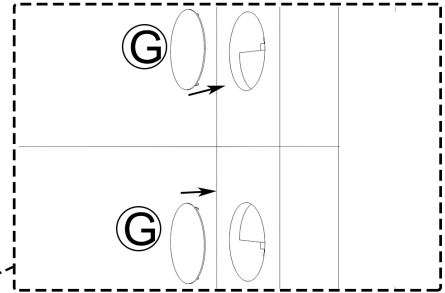

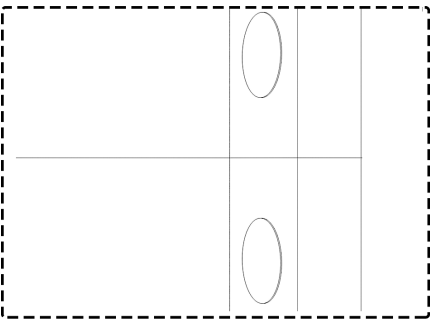
