

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. An adult should always supervise use of this product by children of all ages.
2. Limit: 2 children. Maximum weight per user: 110lbs (50kg).
3. Instruct children not to attach items to the playground equipment that are not specifically designed for use with the equipment (examples: ropes, clothesline, pet leashes, cables and chain, etc) as they may cause a strangulation hazard or any other hazard.
4. Never allow children to use the equipment in a manner other than intended.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

At the beginning of each season as well as at least twice monthly during the usage season:

1. To check all nuts and bolts for tightness and tighten when required;
2. To oil all metallic moving parts;
3. To check all coverings for bolts and sharp edges and replace when required;
4. To check swing seats, chains, ropes and other means of attachments for evidence of deterioration;
5. To replace defective parts in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions

Please have an electrical drill available for assembly if possible

If you have difficulty in installation, please contact us for help and get installation video for reference

Please Ensure:

1. You are assembling with at least two people to ensure that all sides and parts are leveled.
2. You don't screw the parts in too hard or it will splinter the wood.
3. You follow the directions carefully.


Asegúrese de:

3. Siga las instrucciones cuidadosamente.



After screwing in the parts of each section, go back and re-screw them for tightness. If some screws are stubborn, use the manual hex wrench provided








1. Slide bar 27 through one beam then add the middle parts of 18 and 19.

Note: Parts 18-21 go on the ends with these holes



The vertical rope goes through the holes of the middle horizontal bar



