## WARNING

### **WARNING: DEVELOPMENTAL USAGE CRITERIA**

**Start of Use:** This product may only be used when the child has achieved the developmental milestone of holding their head up unassisted, as a minimum requirement.

**Discontinuation of Use:** Cease using this product as a stationary activity center immediately when the child begins to walk unassisted.

**Critical Reminder:** Failure to adhere to these developmental criteria (e.g., using the product before the child meets the minimum developmental level, or continuing use after the child exceeds the applicable stage) may expose the child to safety hazards such as falls, bumps, or other injuries.

### **FALL HAZARD**

Babies can **FALL** from product resulting in head injuries.

- **NEVER** leave child unattended. Always keep child in view while in product or product description.
- **NEVER** use near stairs.
- To avoid tip over, place product on a flat, level surface.

### **STRANGULATION HAZARD**

Strings can cause **STRANGULATION**.

- **DO NOT** place items with a string around child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords.
- **DO NOT** suspend strings over product or attach strings to toys.

Step 2: Pass Part **6** back through the middle hole of Part **6** , and install Part **14** into it.



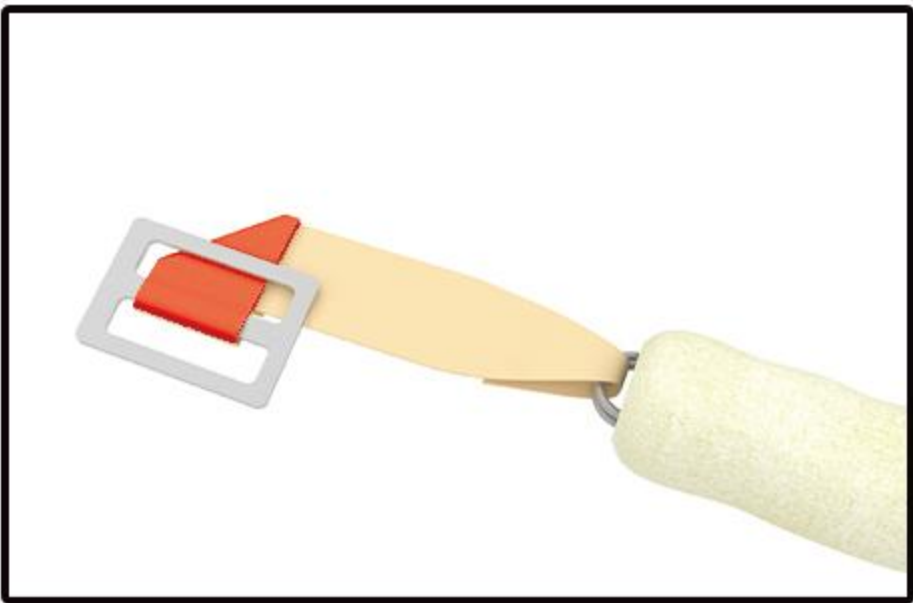
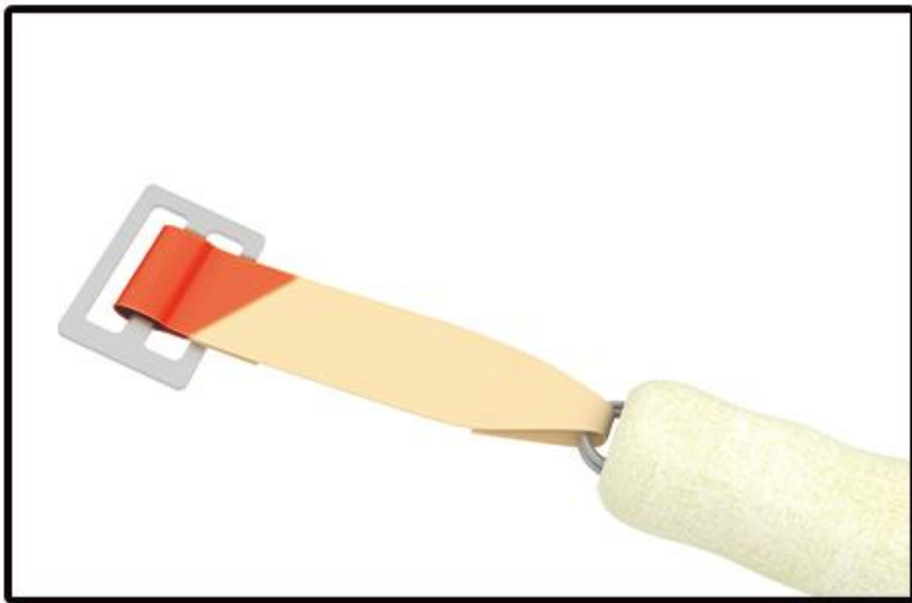
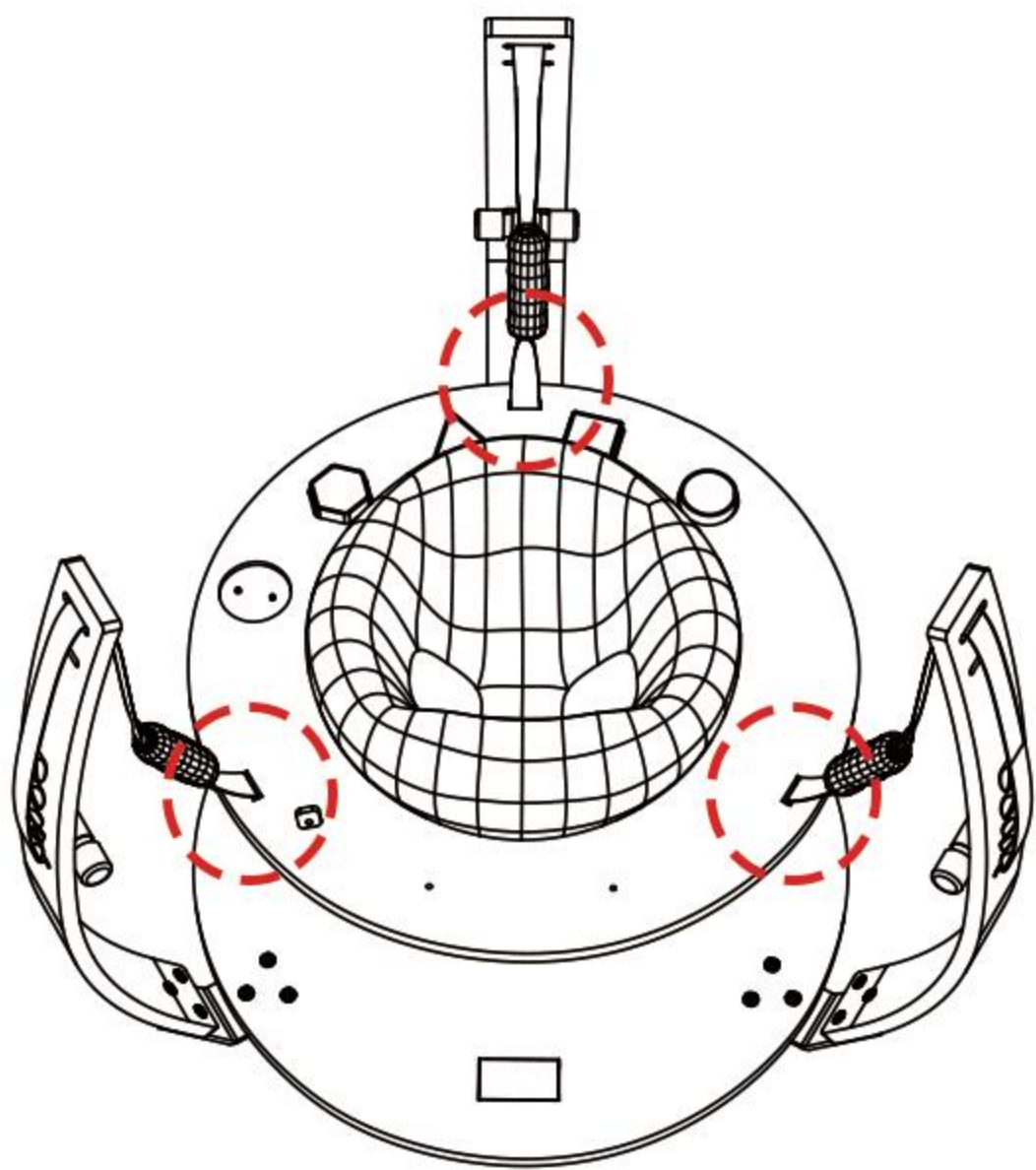
Installation and adjustment of the spring strap

To help you quickly understand the installation and adjustment of the spring strap, we will mark the strap in red in some steps.

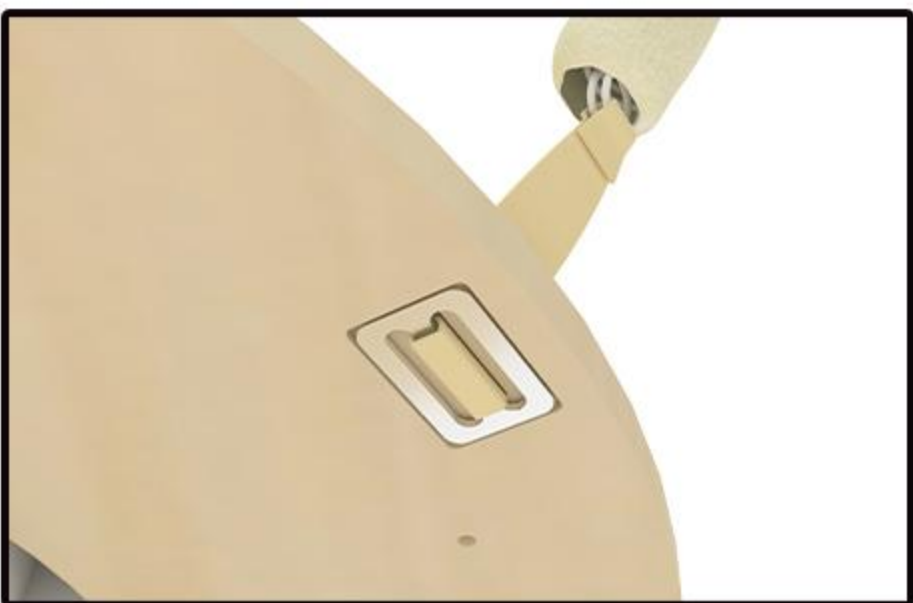
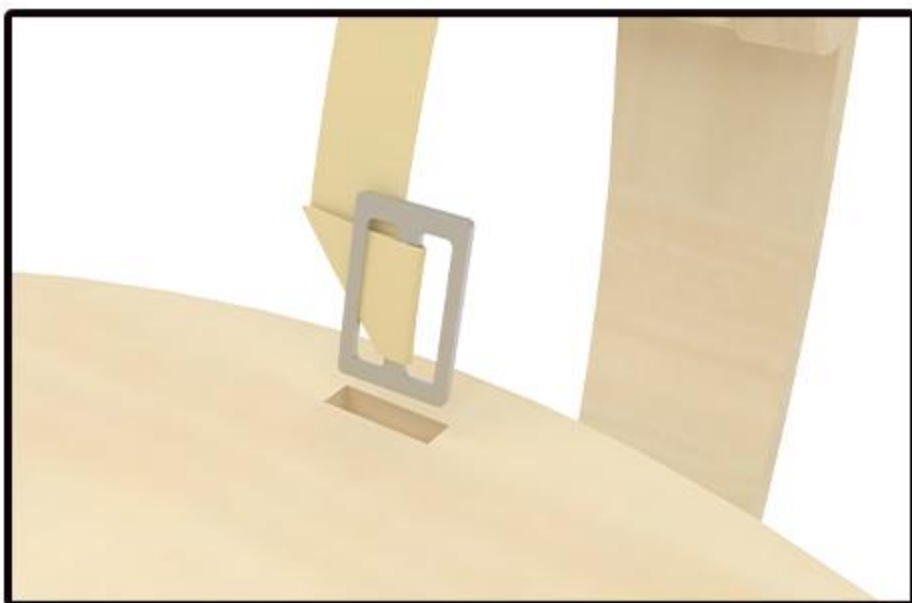
Installation of the spring strap

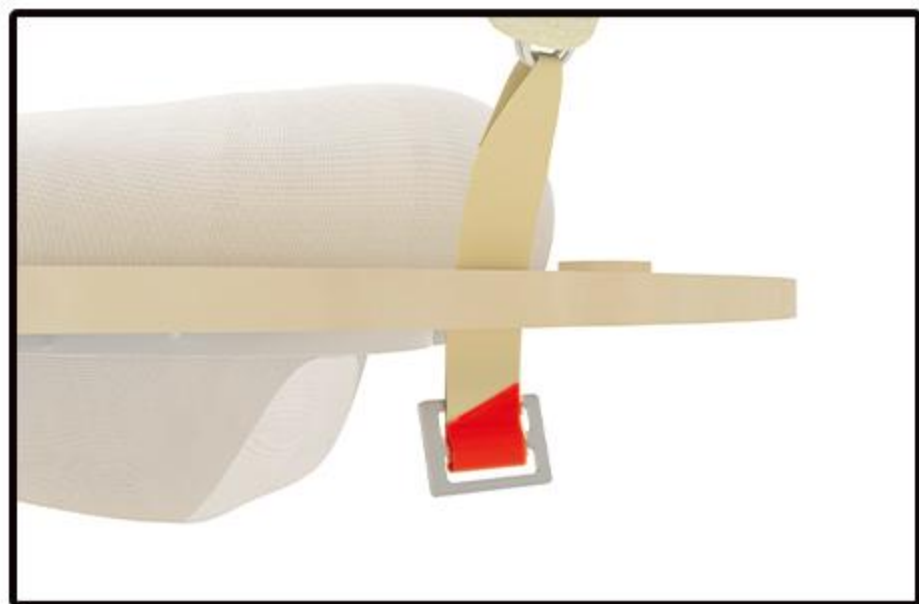
Step 1: Fold the red part of the strap to make it the same as the image on the right.



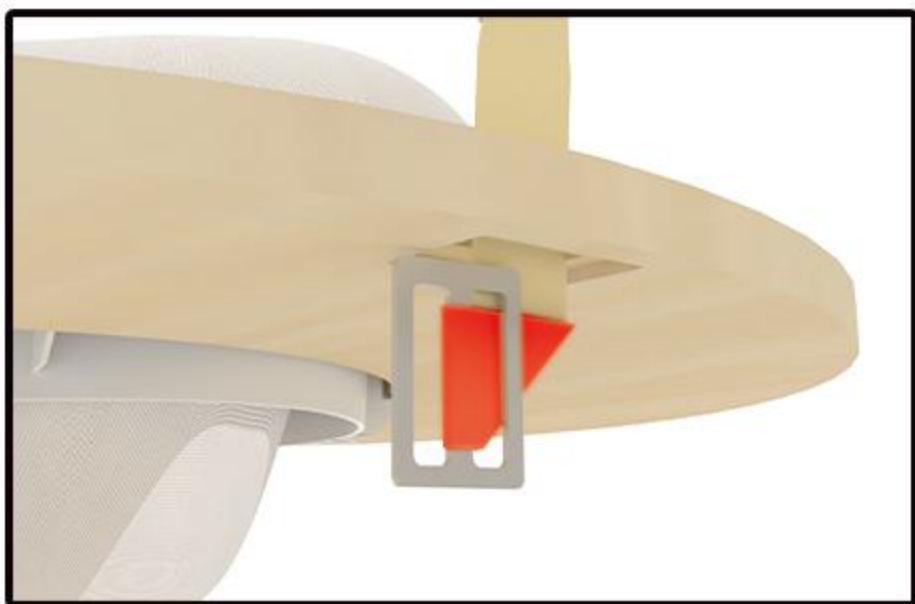
Step 2: Pinch it tightly and thread it through the hole.

Step 3: Open the washer to complete the installation.

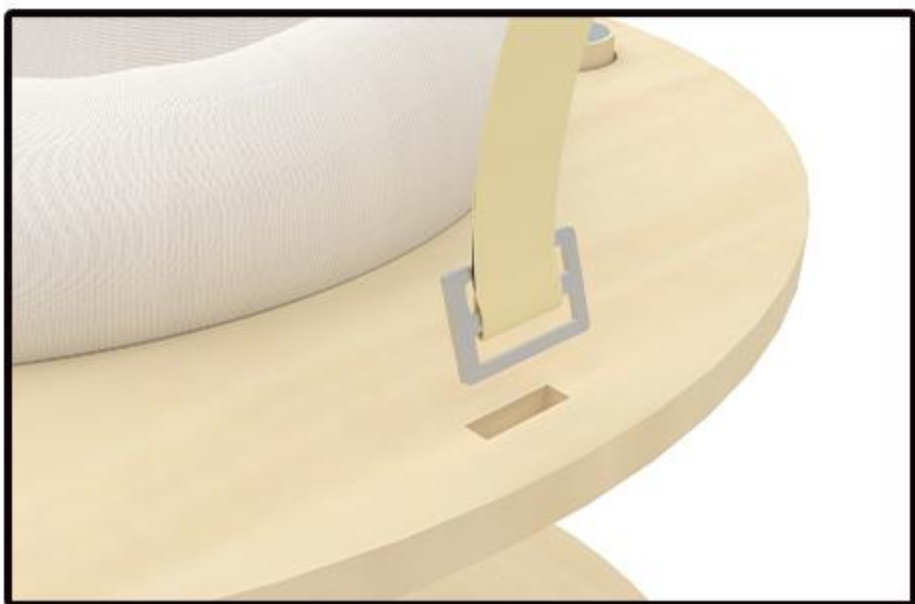

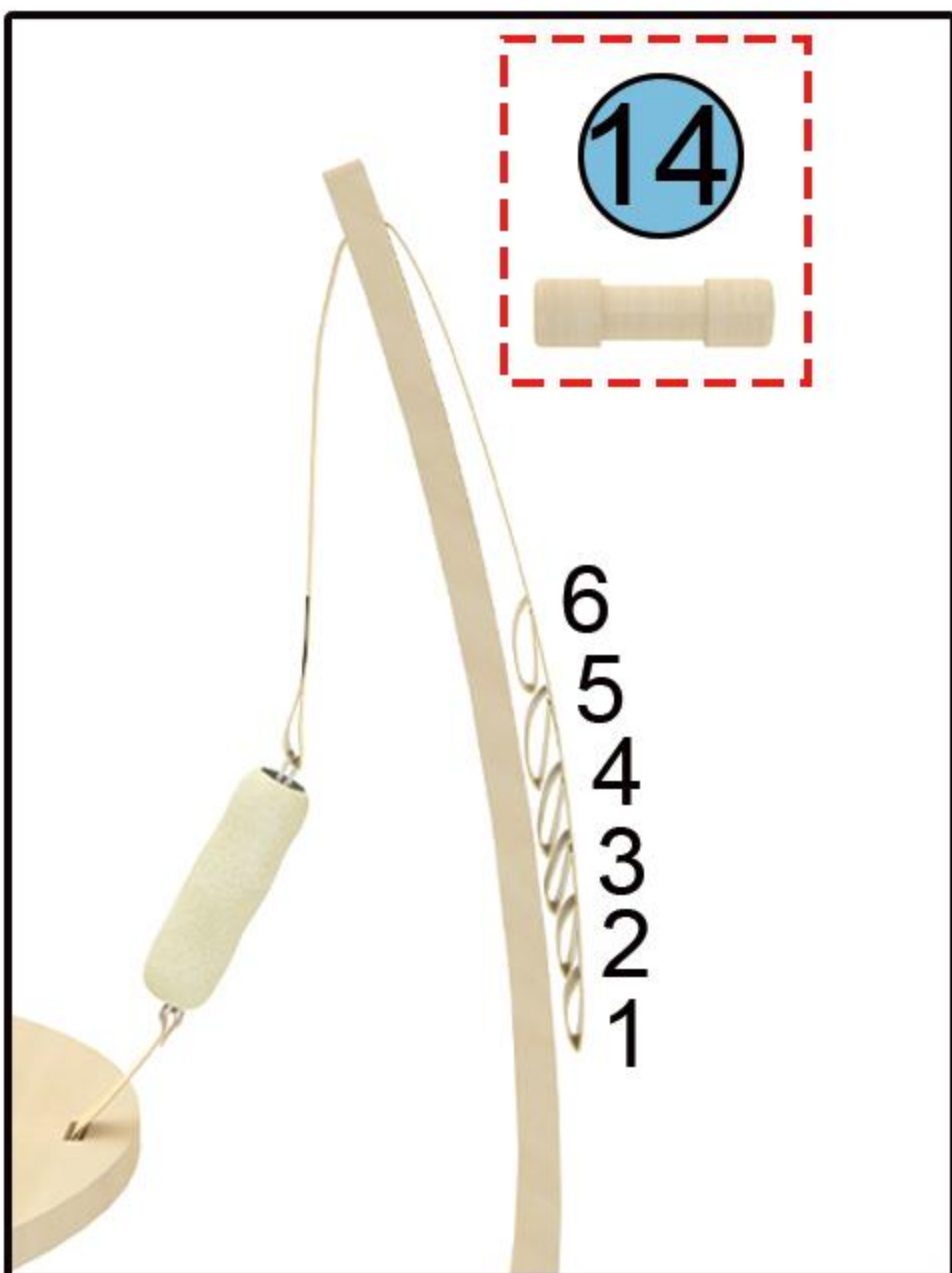

There are 6 gears available for height adjustment, and please use it together with Part 14 .



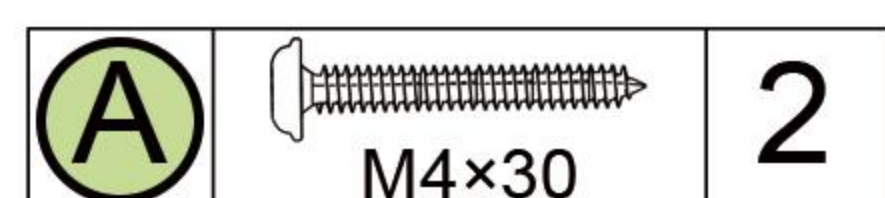
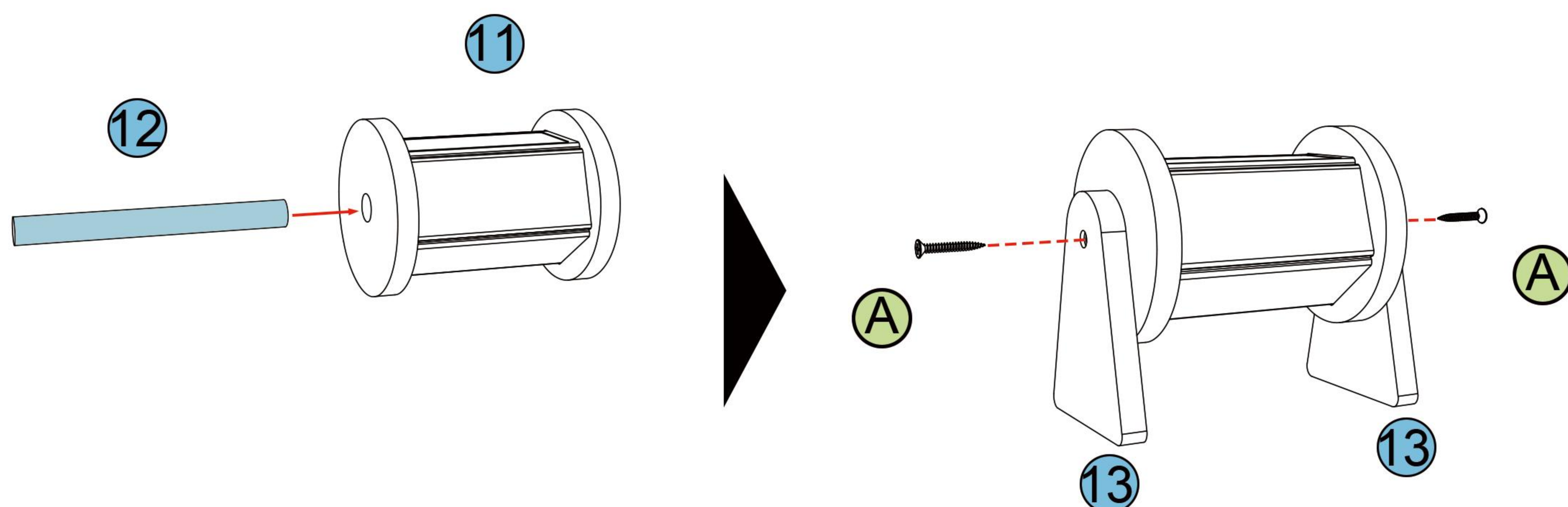
Step 1: After selecting the appropriate gear, thread the strap through the hole.

Step 2: Stretch the strap open and tuck Part 14 into it.

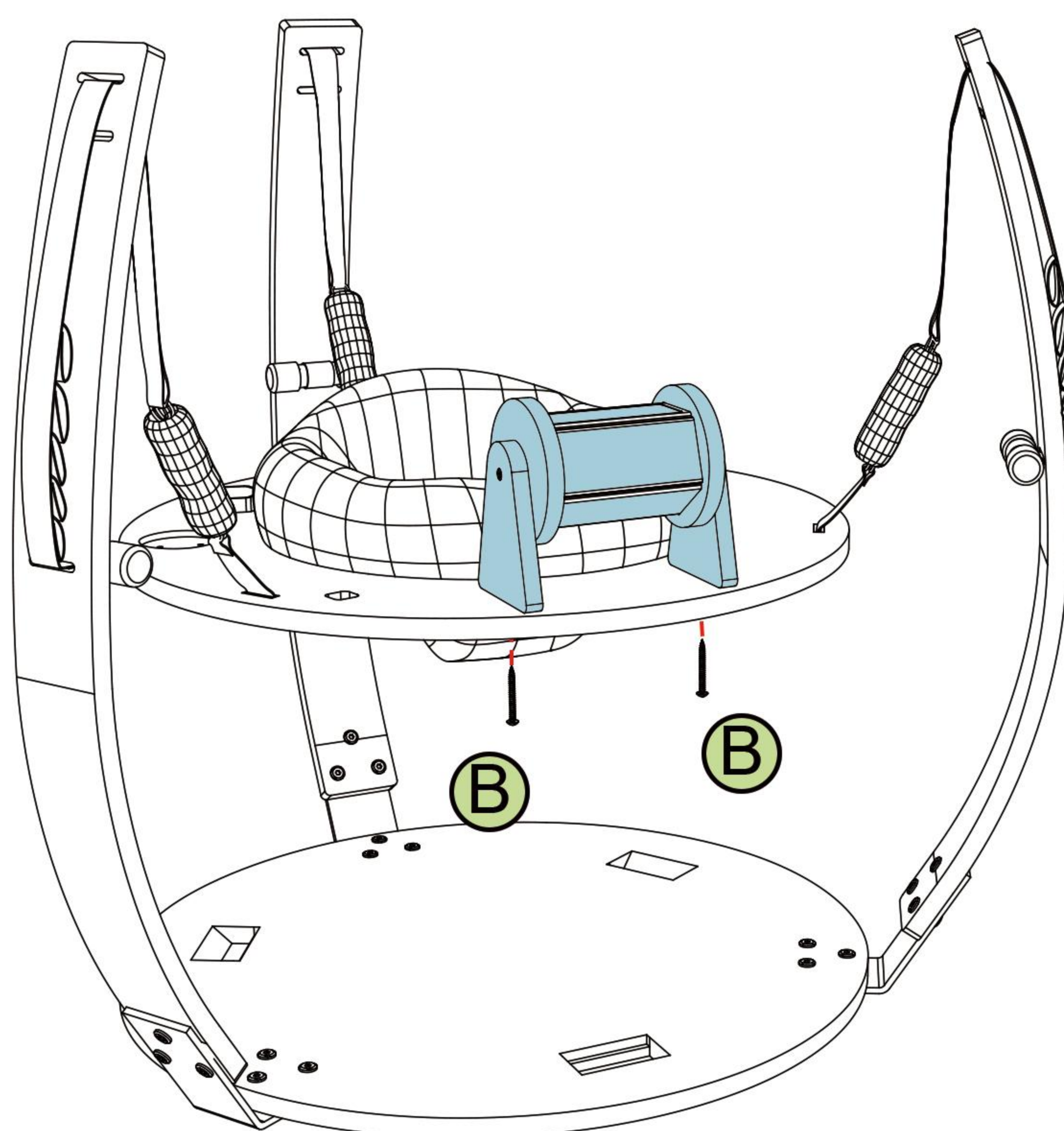
